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## Policy

It is the policy of Big Bend Community Based Care, Inc. (BBCBC), to maintain close ties with the community's served in order to be sensitive to the needs and changing demographics of our constituency, and to communicate and educate about services that we provide.

## Procedure

- A. BBCBC personnel are encouraged to actively participate in community events through sponsorship, partnership, leadership, and dissemination of information to continually reach out to the community for prospective service recipients.
- B. BBCBC personnel are encouraged to participate in community organizations as a vehicle for improving existing services, filling gaps in service, and supporting individuals with special needs.
- C. BBCBC advocates programs to help the service population, as well as educating legislation that will impact community issues.
- D. BBCBC Board of Directors community involvement and advocacy responsibilities are located in the BBCBC Board Policy Manual.
